Public Procurement & eGP

- There **is no direct provision** regarding public procurement **in the Constitution** of Bangladesh
- Public procurement was evolved from the days of **British and Pakistan period**.
- **CGFR issued in 1929** under British rule which outlines general principles for government contracts to follow.
- Procurement Procedures were slightly **amended in 1951**
- **Since independence in 1971**, the public procurement practices have been influenced **by major development** partners like WB, ADB etc.
- Some public sector organization have drafted their own set of procedures or a manual, and others follow **the PWD code** (Form No. 2911 for Works and Form No. 2908 for Goods Procurement)
- **WB and ADB conducted joint review in 1999** of the country portfolio performance and prepared an action plan for government on public procurement.
- **Following the recommendation:**
 - CPTU was established in 2002
 - ~~Public Procurement Regulation 2003~~
 - **Public Procurement Act 2006**
 - **Public Procurement Rules 2008**
 - **eGP Guidelines 2011**

Public Procurement & eGP

CPTU: The CPTU was established in April 2002 as a unit within the Ministry of Planning. Its main responsibility is *“Providing for monitoring compliance with and implementation of Public Procurement Act through the authority as designated by the Government”* (www.cptu.gov.bd)

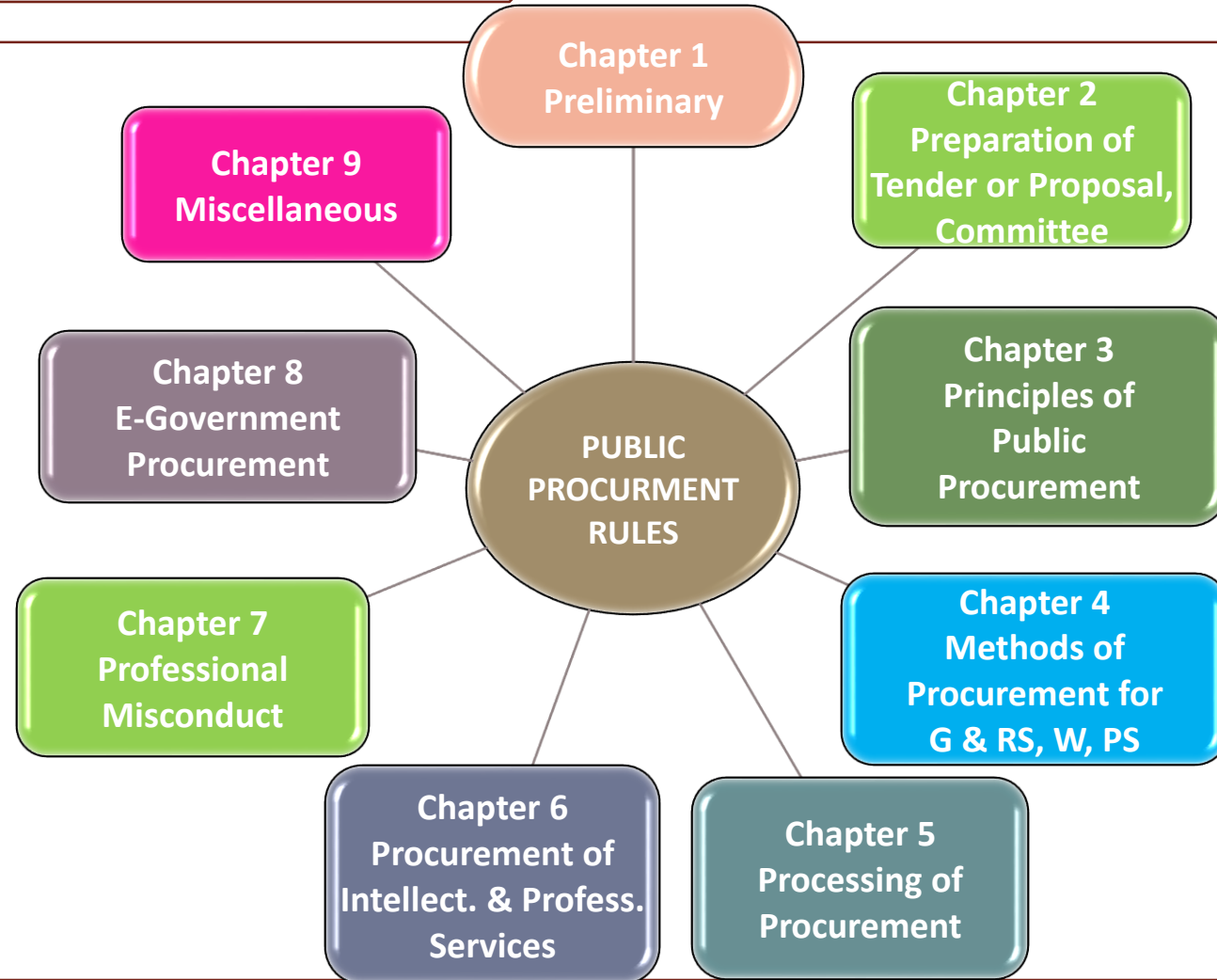
e-GP System: It is a web based system which encompasses the total procurement lifecycle and records the all procurement activities. (www.eprocure.gov.bd)

Public Procurement & eGP

- Public Procurement Act (PPA) 2006 has 9 Chapters, 73 Sections and many sub-sections
- Public Procurement Rules (PPR) 2008 has also 9 chapters, 130 Rules & many sub-rules and 14 schedules annexed.

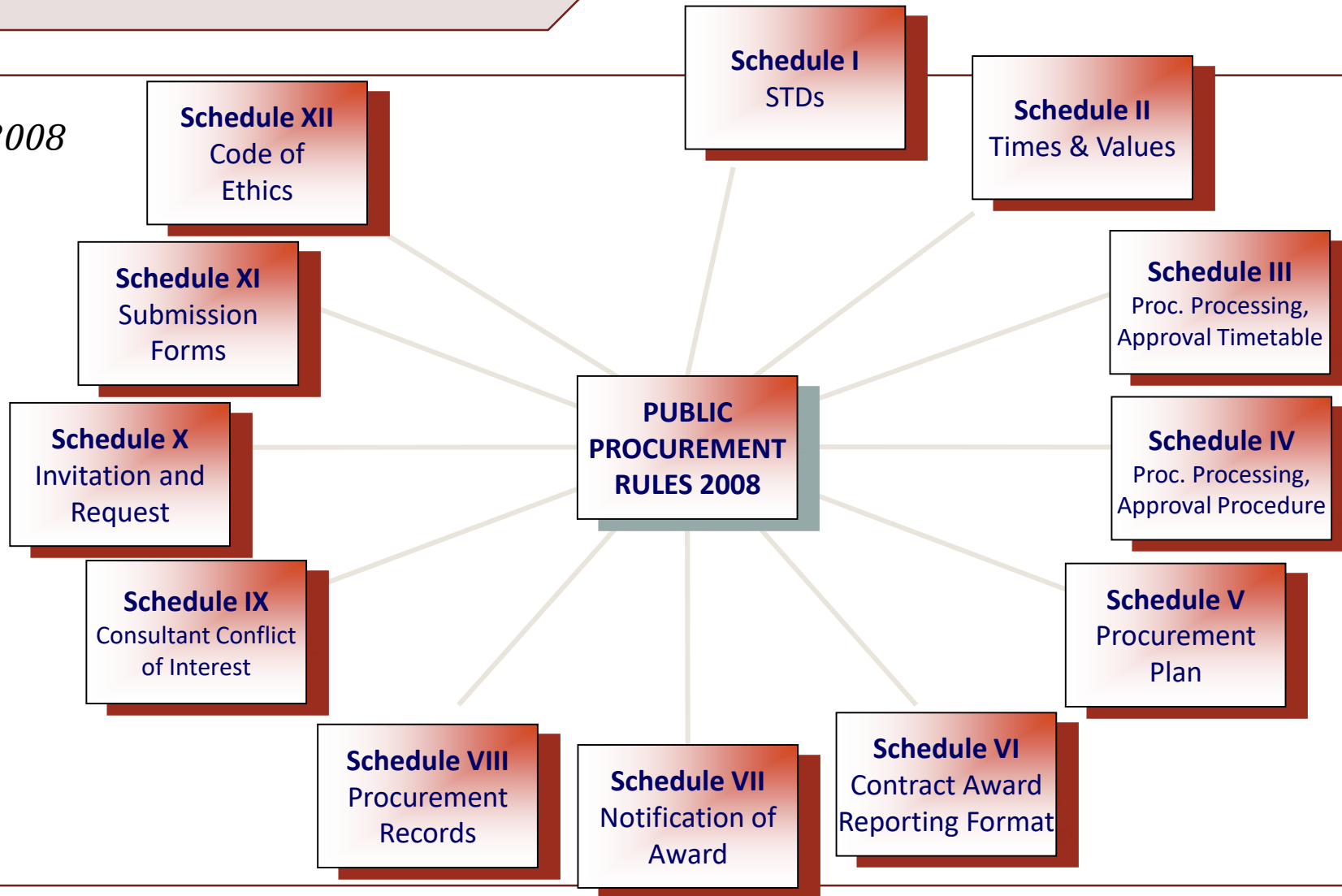

Public Procurement & eGP

Procurement" means the purchasing or hiring of Goods, or acquisition of Goods through purchasing and hiring, and the execution of Works and performance of Services by any contractual means.

Public Procurement is Procurement using Public Funds

Public funds means any fund allocated to a Procuring Entity (PE) under Government Budget, or Loan, Grants and Credits placed at the disposal of a Procuring Entity through the Government by the Development Partners or foreign states or organizations and fund of Government, Semi-Government or statutory organizations created under any law.

"Procuring Entity" means a Procuring Entity having administrative and financial powers to undertake Procurement of Goods, Works or Services using allocated/assigned funds.

Public Procurement & eGP

Head of Procuring Entity (HOPE):

- Secretary of a Ministry or a Division
- Head of a Government Department or Directorate
- Divisional Commissioner, Deputy Commissioner or District Judge or the Chief Executive – by whatever designation the person may be called – of a local Government agency, an autonomous or semi-autonomous Body or a Corporation, or a Body Corporate established under the Companies Act

Public Procurement & eGP

“Works” means all works associated with the construction, reconstruction, site preparation, demolition, repair, maintenance or renovation of railways, roads, highways, or a building, an infrastructure or structure or an installation or any construction work relating to excavation, installation of equipment and materials, decoration, as well as physical services ancillary to works if the value of those services does not exceed that of the Works themselves.

“Goods” means raw materials, products and equipment and objects in solid, liquid or gaseous form, electricity, and related Services if the value of such Services does not exceed that of the Goods themselves.

Service:

"Intellectual and Professional Services" means Services performed by Consultants with outputs of advisory, design, supervision or transfer of a knowhow nature.

"Physical Services" means the following services with measurable outputs, either-

- (a) linked to the supply of Goods or execution of Works such as operation and maintenance of facilities or plant, surveys, exploratory drilling, or
- (b) stand-alone service type contracts such as security services, catering Services, geological Services or third party Services.

Open Tendering method (OTM)

Invite Tenders from Eligible Tenderers through public advertisement
Allowing minimum time for submission as specified

Limited Tendering method (LTM)

A PE may maintain list(s) of enlisted Tenderers for use LTM, and in such cases the Person's qualifications shall be reviewed and updated on an annual basis.
The PE may invite potential Suppliers and Contractors to submit documents in support of their qualifications for enlistment.

One stage two envelop tendering method (OSTEM)

Turnkey Contracts or Contracts for large complex nature of plants when specification, design & BOQ is available with the PE

Two stage two envelop tendering method (TSTEM)

Turnkey Contracts or Contracts for large complex nature of plants where PE lacks the capability to prepare Specification

Request for Quotation Method (RFQM)

"Quotation" means the priced offer in writing received from Tenderers/Suppliers for the procurement of readily available standardized Goods & low value Works or physical Services subject to the financial limitation as prescribed by the Rules

Direct Procurement Method (DPM)

The PE may use the DPM for Procurement for Goods and Related Services, Works and Physical Services from one source without going through Tendering in special circumstances (emergency, only one supplier etc.)

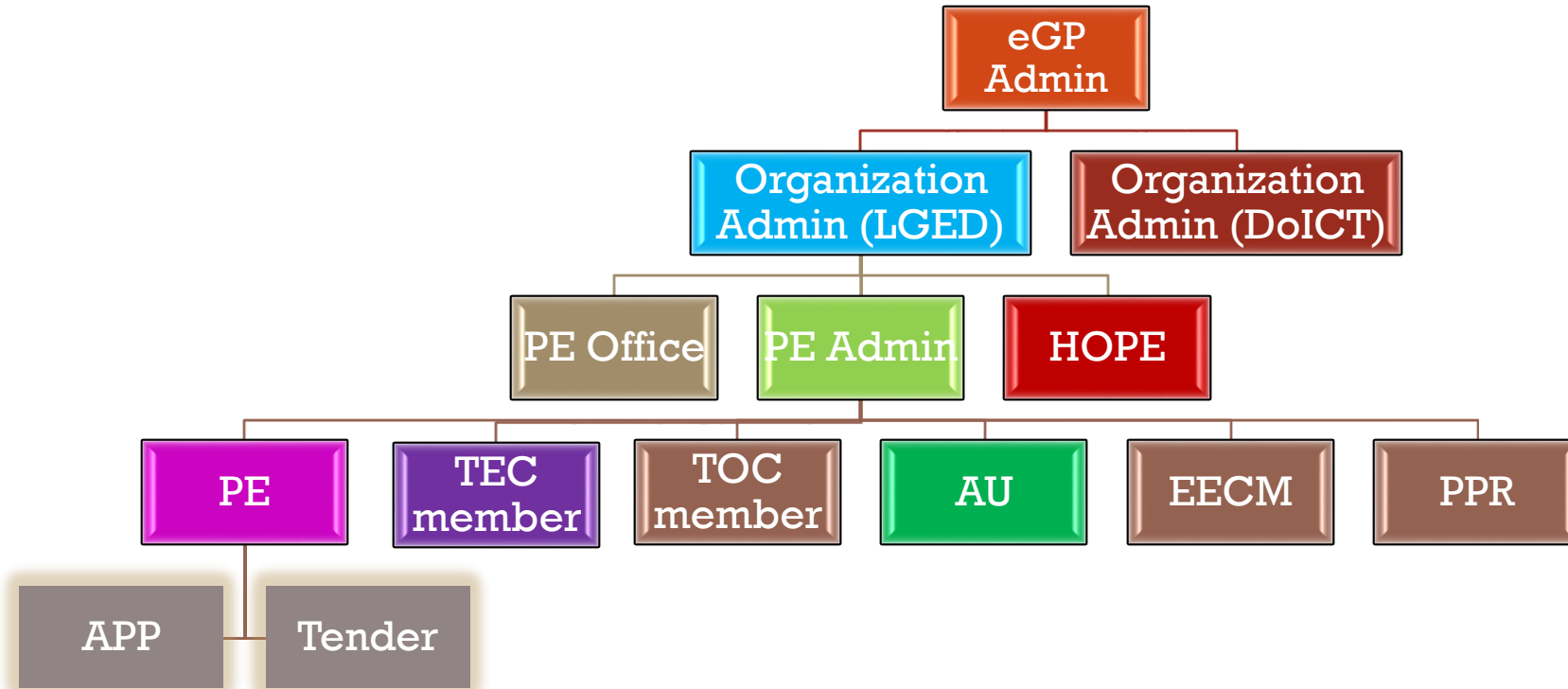

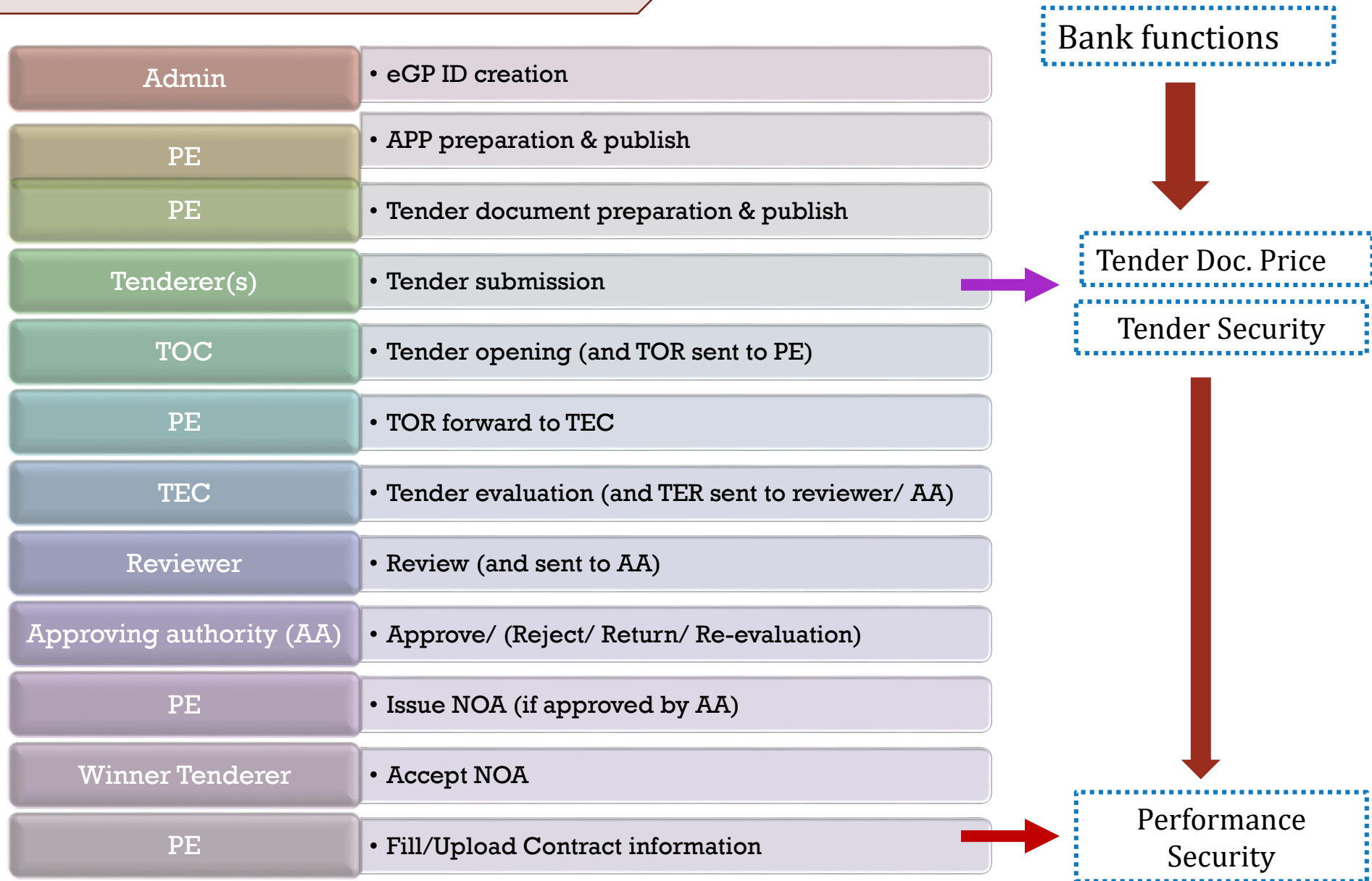

This complete e-GP solution introduced under the Public Procurement Reform (PPR) Program is being supported by the World Bank and gradually used by all government organizations. This online platform also helps them ensuring equal access to the Bidders/Tenderers and also ensuring efficiency, transparency and accountability in the public procurement process in Bangladesh.

Important Messages and Support Details

- The eGP guidelines were approved by the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh in pursuant to Section 65 of the Public Procurement Act, 2006. As per approved guidelines, e-GP system has been introduced and implemented. The eGP system has been developed and introduced in two phases.
- In the first phase, e-Tendering has been introduced on pilot basis in the CPTU and 16 other Procuring Entities (PEs) under 4 (four) sectoral agencies, namely: Bangladesh Water Development Board (BWDB), Local Government Engineering Department (LGED), Roads and Highways Department (RHD) and Rural Electrification Board (REB). The system rolled out to 291 PEs of those 4 sectoral agencies is now expanding to all the PEs of the government up to Districts and sub-Districts level.
- In the second phase, e-Contract Management System (e-CMS) has been developed and introduced and implemented. eCMS is a complete electronic contract management system which provides platform for preparation of work plan and its submission; defining milestone, tracking and monitoring progress, generating reports, performing quality checks, generation of running bills, vendor rating, generation and issuance of completion certificate.

About e-Government Procurement (e-GP) System

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The e-GP system is a single window system which will be able to perform their procurement related activities using a dedicated e-GP Data Center at CPTU, and the e-GP web portal is accessible by the PAs and PEs through internet for their use.

National e-Government Procurement (e-GP) portal (i.e. <https://www.e-gp.gov.bd>) of the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh is developed, owned and being operated by the Central Procurement Technical Unit (CPTU), IRE Division of Ministry of Planning. The e-GP system provides an on-line platform to carry out the procurement activities by the Public Agencies - Procuring Agencies (PAs) and Procuring Entities (PEs).

The e-GP system is a single web portal from where and through which PAs and PEs will be able to perform their procurement related activities using a dedicated secured web based dashboard. The e-GP system is hosted in e-GP Data Center at CPTU, and the e-GP web portal is accessible by the PAs and PEs through internet for their use.

This complete e-GP solution introduced under the Public Procurement Reform (PPR) Program is being supported by the World Bank and gradually used by all government organizations. This online platform also helps them ensuring equal access to the Bidders/tenders and also ensuring efficiency, transparency and accountability in the public procurement process in Bangladesh.

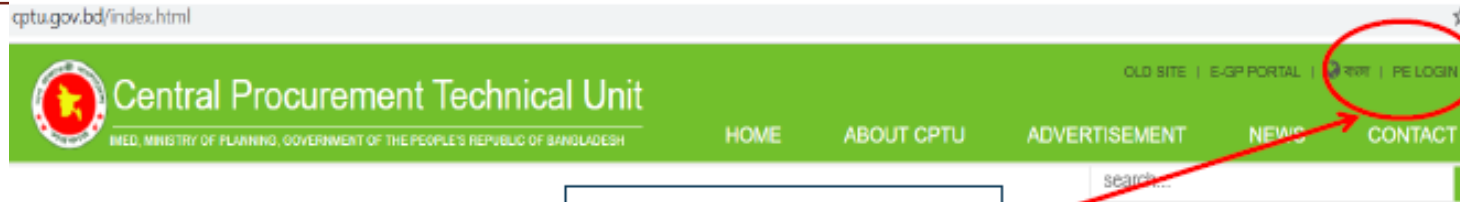

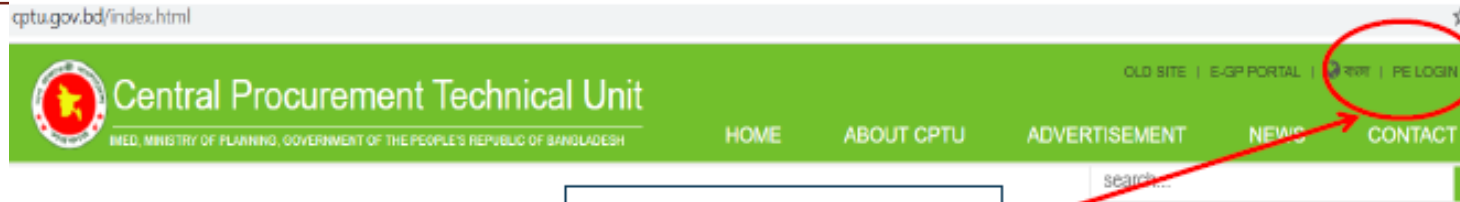

Annual Procurement Plan- Time bound Procurement assists a Procuring Entity to effectively plan its Procurement requirements and is an important and useful tool used to monitor the progress of Procurement (a) to ensure that it does not go astray; (b) to ensure that early problems with slippage can be dealt with promptly; and (c) can form a useful Annual Plan for Procurement.

A separate Schedule should be provided for Goods, Works and Services.

Also a separate schedule should be used for Development or Revenue Budget.
